**Re: Year 8 visit to Manchester Museum of Science and Industry 5<sup>th</sup> March 2018**

I am pleased to invite your son/daughter to a drop down day visit to Manchester Museum of Science and Industry on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2018.

This is an exciting opportunity to visit one of the country's leading science museums and take part in a day full of interactive activities led by staff at the museum; including the Human vs Machine Show as well as demonstrations of the machines at the museum and a visit to the experiment zone.

Students will need to arrive at the normal time for the beginning of the school day (8:40am) and will be transported by coach to the museum. We intend for all the coaches to arrive back at school by 3:00pm.

They will also have the opportunity to visit the museum gift shop and students may bring with them a sensible amount of money. Packed lunches will be provided for students who normally receive free school meals.
